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Anti-Glycine receptor Alpha3, NeuroMab clone N424/45

Immunogen:

Fusion protein amino acids 342-431 (cytoplasmic loop) of human GlyRAlpha3L (also known as Glycine receptor subunit alpha-3 and GLRA3, accession number O75311)

Mouse: 95% identity (86/90 amino acids identical) Rat: 93% identity (84/90 amino acids identical)

>80% identity with GlyRAlpha3K (amino acids 358-372 or TEAFALEKFYRFSDM is L-specific)

~50% identity with GlyRAlpha1 and GlyRAlpha2
